

2020 NEA-RA STATE DELEGATE ELECTION TIMELINE

January 31

REVISED

5:00 p.m. - Deadline for returning Declaration of Candidacy Forms to SESCO. The Service Center is not responsible for FAX transmission errors.

Deadline for locals to establish election timelines for local RA Delegates. Chapter elections must conclude by **March 20**.

February 21 – March 20 – CONDUCT ELECTION ELECTRONICALLY



March 20

4:30 p.m. – Deadline to vote by paper ballot at CTA Region 3 – 11745 E. Telegraph Rd., Santa Fe Springs, CA 90670. Electronic Voting closes at 4:30pm.

March 24

Voted Paper Ballots counted by SESCO Elections Committee and announcement of results.

**Deadline for filing a challenge to the election (date received, not date postmarked) is four (4) calendar days after the ballots are counted, including any run-offs if necessary.*

April 6

Deadline: Election results must be received by 5:00 p.m. to the CTA Elections and Credentials Committee (postmark date not accepted)

April 13

Delegates who have been elected as **both local and state delegate positions must notify the Service Center Council of the position selected (Delegates may not hold both positions)**

April 20

Service Center Council chairperson must notify CTA of names of successor state delegates if an elected state delegate chooses to go as a local delegate

June 1

Deadline for filing an appeal of the CTA Board of Directors decision on a challenge with the NEA Credentials Committee regarding alleged violations of election requirements.
